SMALL BEGINNINGS TO GREAT IMPACT

How to Use this 7-Day Devotional

Read: Read the prompted Ezekiel 47 verse(s) for the day.

Reflection: After reading the prompted verse(s), you will be given a thought provoking statement followed by a reflective question to consider for the day.

Prayer: Consider the prompted verse(s) and reflective question then seek the Lord in

prayer to draw closer to Him.

Goal: Grow your trust in the Lord who can turn small beginnings into a great impact.

Day 1: The Source of the River

Read: Ezekiel 47:1

Reflection: Everything begins at the temple—God's presence. How connected are

you to the source of life?

Prayer: Lord, help me to stay rooted in Your presence give me a deeper awareness of Your presence in my life and church. Reveal to me where I need to surrender and let the Holy Spirit flow. I pray that Your presence leads our church's vision and plans.

Day 2: The River Starts Small

Read: Ezekiel 47:2

Reflection: Do not despise small beginnings. What small step is God calling you to

take today?

Prayer: Father, give me faith to trust that small acts of obedience can lead to great results. I pray for encouragement for my church as our small beginnings can truly make a big and everlasting impact with You as our Source.

Day 3: Ankle-Deep Faith

Read: Ezekiel 47:3

Reflection: Ankle-deep water is safe and easy. Are you staying in shallow faith

because it feels comfortable?

Prayer: God, help me to trust You to lead me into deeper waters by showing me small steps of faith to take. Grant me boldness to go beyond shallow waters as I trust in Your promises. I pray our church embraces growth even when it feels uncomfortable.

Day 4: Trusting in Deeper Waters

Read: Ezekiel 47:4

Reflection: Waist-deep water requires more trust. How can you surrender more

control to God?

Prayer: Lord, I trust You to lead me deeper, even when it feels uncertain. I believe that You will guide me as I navigate new waters that lead to abundant life as Your

Word tells me.

Day 5: Overflowing Growth

Read: Ezekiel 47:5

Reflection: The river grows until it cannot be crossed. Are you open to letting God's

power exceed your expectations?

Prayer: Lord, let Your Spirit overflow in my life and our church. I pray that the current

flowing from the Living Water carries us into a season of growth that You have

already put in motion.

Day 6: Bringing Healing

Read: Ezekiel 47:8-9

Reflection: The river heals and restores. How is God calling you to bring healing to

others?

Prayer: Father, use me as an instrument of Your healing and love to bring life to those around me. Provide opportunities for me to bring hope and healing as well as my church to minister to those who are hurting and lost in our community. I pray that Your river flows through our city, transforming lives and communities.

Day 7: Bearing Fruit

Read: Ezekiel 47:12

Reflection: Trees by the river bear fruit every month. How can you live a fruitful life

for God?

Prayer: Lord, help me to live a life that bears eternal fruit. Your Word says that the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few, I pray that I become the type of laborer that partners with You to produce fruitful followers of Christ.
