# Sword Method Sample (Bible Study)

Scripture: Psalm 119:105-112

## What did you learn about God?

*What does this passage reveal about God's character? His heart? His actions?*

God guides His people. God's Word provides direction. God is faithful even during affliction. God is worthy of continual praise.

## Is there a sin to avoid?

*Is there a warning? Is there an attitude to reject? Is there a behavior to adjust?*

Ignoring God's direction. Following our own path. Drifting from God's Word.

## Is there a command to obey?

*What action does God want me to take?*

Obey God's Word. Remain faithful.

## Is there a promise to trust

*What truth can I cling to? What confidence does God provide?*

God's Word will guide us. God's testimonies are an inheritance forever.

## Is there an example to follow?

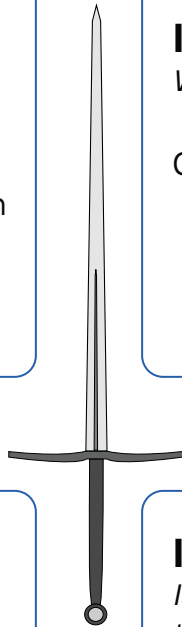
*Is there someone demonstrating faithful living? Is there an attitude worth imitating?*

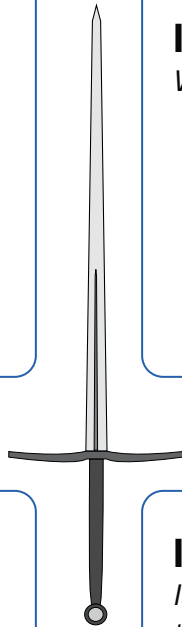
